

Business Talent Group Named to Inc. 5000 List of America's Fastest Growing Private Companies Second Year Running

BTG achieved an impressive 209% revenue growth rate between 2011 and 2016, placing it at No. 1781 overall, and No. 128 in the Business Products & Services industry. Being selected for the prestigious Inc. 5000 list for the second year in a row reflect BTG's explosive growth and mirrors that of the "Independent Economy," which a 2015 Freelance Union/Upwork survey pegged at almost 54 million people, or 1/3 of the U.S. workforce.

Dubbed by the magazine as the "superheroes of the economy" and a "Roll call of quantified, verified business successes," ", the Inc. 5000 list is where now household names such as Microsoft, Zappos, Intuit, Jamba Juice, Zipcar, Intuit, Chobani and Oracle first made their mark. Companies on the 2016 Inc. 5000 list grew their revenues a "dazzling" 253.261% over the last three years, creating a total of 55,704 jobs.
